Afternoon - opportunity to walk the labyrinth, spend some time in the hospital grounds, and then return home when you are ready.

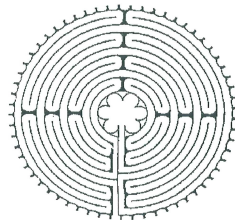
